### Member Meetings

- Monthly on the first Saturday of each month at 6 pm
- Social hour – bar is open for this event
- Potluck supper
- Short business meeting
- Speaker or program – The Senior Board Member schedules the program
  - Contact the SBM if you have a suggestion for a speaker or program

### Annual Meeting

- November of each year on the first Saturday
  - Social hour and potluck supper
  - Bar is open for this event
- Annual business meeting for the club
  - Voting on officers for the upcoming year
  - Annual reports from the current officers
  - Other necessary club business
- No speaker or program is scheduled for this meeting

### CiA – Changes in Attitude

- Monthly on the last Saturday of each month at 6 pm
- Bar is open for this event
- Members volunteer to host this event (single or group)
  - Set up and Clean up
- Can be a theme (ask Junior Board Member about decorations)
- Meant to be heavy hors d'oeuvres but some members do more
  - Don't let that scare you off hosting
- Up to \$50 reimbursement for food cost
  - Submit request with receipt to ABYC Purser

### Commodores' Happy Hour

- One or more of the ABYC Commodores are your bar tender for the evening
- These are randomly scheduled and are put on the ABYC calendar

## **Paid Events** – these are catered events

- RSVP required (usually online via club event calendar)
- Cost will be billed on your next club invoice
- Events
  - Commodore's Ball – January or February
    - Commodore is responsible for arrangements
  - Spring Opening – March
  - Vice Commodore's Ball / Dinner / Party
    - Vice Commodore is responsible for arrangements
  - Awards Ceremony & Banquet
  - Christmas Party\* & Yankee Gift Swap

## **Other Events**

- Other events are held during the year.
  - New Year's Day – Traditional Southern Dinner
  - After Thanksgiving – Leftover Feast following Gobbler Regatta
  - New Year's Eve Party\* – bring an appetizer to share
  - Soup, Stew and Chili (good time is February Membership Meeting)
  - They may be club sponsored or members can suggest and host
    - Schedule with the Junior Board Member
  - These have included but are not limited to:
    - Movie nights\*, Dinner on the Docks, Casino Night\*, Luau\*, Pirate Party\*, Super Bowl Party\*, Cinco de Mayo, Game Night, Sailor's Drinking Society Night (Sept), Pool Party, Cook Out, Ice Cream Social, Art Show, Summer Picnic, Italian Night\*, Caribbean Night, Blue Hawaii, Black Tot Day (July 31 *1970 the last day on which the Royal Navy issued sailors with a daily rum ration (the daily tot)*), Low Country Boil...

## **Private Events**

- Members may schedule the clubhouse for a private event
  - Contact the Junior Board Member for scheduling
  - The Member is responsible for set up and clean up and making sure all club rules are followed.
  - The Pool and Restrooms remain open for all members to use during the private event.
- There is a full kitchen available for your use

## **Work Days**

- Work Days are set by the Board of Directors with the Rear Commodore in charge
